Security

Our school is a locked facility. Video cameras outside monitor our facility 24 hours a day. Visitors are screened before gaining entrance to our school.

Infant/Toddler Program (ages 6 weeks-35 months)

Infants and toddlers experience incredible growth and change in the first three years of life and have different needs at each stage. We believe children of this young age should be nurtured and cared for as if they were in a "home environment". Caregiving is a most essential part of the curriculum; teachable moments arise during diapering and toileting (including toilet training), meals and feedings, dressing and napping. Our curriculum activities emerge from individual child's interests and abilities. Our classrooms are set up to encourage exploration and discovery. Each area offers a wide range of choice from which the children can select. Materials in art, science, literacy, math, movement and dramatic play are available to the children. Classroom ratios are set by NAEYC standards. This provides your young child with the nurturing and individual attention necessary to grow and thrive.

Preschool Program (ages 3years-5years)

Our program strives to meet the needs of these important years by addressing the whole child. Children are involved in a wide variety of learning activities to enhance their cognitive and motor development. They are motivated to reach their potential through many activities in the areas of art, drama, music, creative movement and more. This potential is developed in a warm, relaxed environment where children can see, hear, touch, smell and taste. Readiness in reading,

math, social studies, language arts and science is developed through individual and group activities. We encourage individuality, independence and a sense of responsibility. Our school provides a quality early childhood environment that allows each child to develop at his/her own rate socially, emotionally and intellectually. Our program provides experiences as the best source of true learning for a preschool child. We offer our students a balance between self-directed, hands-on activities and teacher-guided learning experiences. We use the Creative Curriculum as our guidelines for appropriate practices.

VPK Program

(Must be 4 years by 9/1)

We are proud participants of the **Florida Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Education Program (VPK)**. Our VPK program is designed to give our children the tools needed to be successful in Kindergarten. Our children have proven successful through top Florida Kindergarten Ready Screener (FLKRS) scores (assessed in Kindergarten).
